WWAARC RECIEVES \$52,250.00 in GRANTS FROM NYSARC TRUST SERVICES

SLINGERLANDS, NY – Warren, Washington, and Albany Counties ARC (WWAARC), a chapter of the Arc NY, received \$52,250 from two grants it graciously received in the spring of 2023 from the NYSARC Trust Services. These funds were used to enhance and enrich the lives of people we support in our Guardianship and Recreation programs.

The WWAARC Guardianship Committee and people we support with Guardianship Services are very thankful for the generous contributions of \$35,250.00 they received from the NYSARC Trust Services. Our Guardianship Committee members provide thoughtful and responsible supports and services to six people who would not otherwise have a legal guardian. They respect the individualized Guardianship Services needed by each person in an ethical, competent manner with dignity, compassion, and trust. The Guardians encourage and support the person's meaning of quality of life; assist people supported to be actively involved with their own lives to the extent possible including decision-making and other aspects of everyday living.

As 2023 unfolded, holidays, birthdays and the change of seasons were honored with gifts that those receiving Guardianship Services cherished, experiences that they remembered which brought out their individual personalities and talents, discussions on health and wellbeing and sometimes the difficulties of life, the true feeling of friendships and understanding did not waver.

Throughout 2023, we remembered the value of Guardianship Services not only for those receiving the supports, but also for the Guardianship Committee as "guardianship is a continuous life-long relationship of trust". This generous Guardianship Grant from the NYSARC Trust Services offered our Committee opportunities to support and assist those people receiving Guardianship Services to pursue their life interests.

WWAARC sends our true appreciation to the NYSARC Trust Services Trustees for a grant that focuses on well-being and quality of life of each person supported with Guardianship Services.

NYSARC Trust Services also awarded WWAARC \$17,000 to support recreational opportunities in our Day and Residential Programs.
